# **PRIVACY** Policy

This privacy policy explains how 4CM Ltd. uses any personal information we collect about you. We follow the guidelines provided by the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) in order to comply with General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). We are listed on the public register for data controllers maintained by the ICO.

For the purpose of the GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) and PECR (Privacy and Electronic Communication Regulation) the data processor is 4CM Ltd, Challenge House, Sherwood Drive, Bletchley, Milton Keynes, MK3 6DP.

#### As Your Data Processor

As a marketing agency, 4CM will use customer data that is supplied for campaigns and projects as specifically instructed by clients (the controller). If you are another marketing company, sub-contracting a data processing task to 4CM you become our data controller.

## WHY we collect personal data

We collect and process data:

- To ensure that content from our website is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your internet browsers
- To provide you with information, products or services that you may be interested in or have requested
- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts or transactions entered into between us
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our service, when you choose to do so
- To notify you about changes to our services
- To ensure we are providing a service that meets your requirements.



## WHAT personal data is collected and processed

The data we hold for different purposes may include:

- Personal contact information including name and contact details such as email, telephone number, social media handles and postal address
- Demographic information, including job title and function, date of birth, location, personal preferences and interests
- Financial details for invoicing and payment purposes
- Customer feedback, including information that you share with 4CM Ltd about your experience in using 4CM Ltd's services or those of our clients
- Customer-generated content, including any content that you create and then share with 4CM Ltd by uploading it to a 4CM Ltd website
- Data such as dietary requirements for events and images for use in 4CM or our client's marketing the required notices will be provided at point of data collection.





## **HOW** personal data is collected

We may collect personal data about you from the following sources:

- Online and electronic interactions, including via 4CM Ltd websites
- Offline interactions with us, including via hard copy registration cards, competition entries, event registrations or phone contact
- Your interaction with online targeted content (such as advertisements) that 4CM Ltd, provide to you via third party websites or applications
- Cookies and other tracking technology which collect certain kinds of information when you interact with 4CM Ltd sites. Please see our cookie notice for information on these technologies and your rights in relation to them
- External links Although we look to include quality, safe and relevant external links across our websites, users are advised to adopt a policy of caution before clicking any external web links. (External links include clickable text / banner / image links to other websites)
- From clients who have requested our marketing services and have provided us with your data for us to contact you
  on their behalf.

Please note: We cannot guarantee or verify the contents of any externally linked website despite our best efforts. Users should therefore note that they click on external links at their own risk and that this website and its owners cannot be held liable for any damages or implications caused by visiting any external links mentioned.





### **IP** addresses and cookies

We may collect information about your computer, including where available your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and optimisation. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns and does not identify any individual.

For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. They help us to improve our site and to deliver a better and more personalised service. They enable us:

- To estimate our audience size and usage pattern
- To store information about your preferences, and so allow us to customise our site according to your individual interests
- To speed up your searches
- To recognise you when you return to our site
- You may refuse to accept cookies by activating the setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you
  may be unable to access certain parts of our website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will
  refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you log on to our site
- In addition, cookies from third parties such as Twitter and Google are included on our websites.

- Our website contains links to other websites. This privacy policy only applies to 4CM websites. We recommend
  that you check the policy of each site you visit and contact its owner or operator if you have any concerns
  or questions.





Generally, the cookies that are used on our sites can be broken down into the following categories:

#### **Session Cookies**

These cookies are used 'in-session' each time you visit and then expire when you leave a site or shortly thereafter: they are not stored on your device permanently, do not contain any personal data and help by minimising the need to transfer personal data across the internet. These cookies can be deleted, or you can refuse to allow their use, but this will hamper the performance and your experience in using the sites. These cookies also take time stamps that record when you access a site and when you leave a site.

#### **Tracking Cookies**

These cookies enable us to recognise repeat visitors to our sites. By matching an anonymous, randomly generated identifier, a tracking cookie keeps track of where a user of our sites came from, which search engine they may have used, which link they clicked on, which keyword they used and where they were in the world when they accessed a site. By monitoring this data, we can make improvements to our sites.

#### **Persistent Cookies**

This type of cookie is saved on your device for a fixed period (sometimes for a few hours, sometimes for a year or longer) and is not deleted when the browser is closed. Persistent cookies are used where we need to remember who you are for more than one browsing session. For example, this type of cookie can be used to store your preferences, so that they are remembered for the next visit to a site.

#### **Performance or Analytical Cookies**

Performance cookies are used to analyse how the sites are used and to monitor their performance, which allows us to improve your experience in using the sites. These cookies help us to tailor the content of the sites to reflect what the site users find most interesting and to identify when technical issues with the sites arise. We may also use this data to compile reports to help us analyse how sites are used, what the most common issues are and how we can improve the sites.

#### Opt-out for cookies used for online advertising - Just in case

You can also manage many companies' cookies used for online advertising via the consumer choice tools created under self-regulation programs in many countries, such as the EU-based <a href="http://www.youronlinechoices.com/uk/your-ad-choices">http://www.youronlinechoices.com/uk/your-ad-choices</a>.

You can withdraw your consent to the use of consent based cookies individually at any time with effect for the future by adjusting your cookie settings accordingly.





## 4CM marketing

#### **Email Newsletter**

We operate an email newsletter program, used to inform subscribers about our work, and services. Users can subscribe through an online automated process should they wish to do so. Some subscriptions may be manually processed following agreement via email or telephone.

Subscriptions are taken in compliance with GDPR and PECR. All personal details relating to subscriptions are held securely and in accordance with GDPR/PECR. No personal details are passed on to third parties nor shared with companies / people outside 4CM Ltd. You may request a copy of personal information held about you by 4CM Ltd's email newsletter program.

Our email marketing campaigns may contain tracking facilities within the actual email. Subscriber activity is tracked and stored in a database for future analysis and evaluation. Such tracked activity may include: the opening of emails, forwarding of emails, the clicking of links within the email content, times, dates and frequency of activity (this is not a comprehensive list).

This information is used to refine future email campaigns and supply users with more relevant content based around their activity.

In compliance with GDPR and PECR subscribers are given the opportunity to un-subscribe at any time through an automated system. This process is detailed at the footer of each email campaign. If an automated un-subscription system is unavailable clear instructions on how to un-subscribe will be detailed instead.

#### Social Media Platforms

Communication, engagement and actions taken through external social media platforms that we participate on are customised to the terms and conditions as well as the privacy policies held with each social media platform respectively.

Users are advised to use social media platforms wisely and communicate / engage upon them with due care and caution in regard to their own privacy and personal details. We will never ask for personal or sensitive information through social media platforms and encourage users wishing to discuss sensitive details to contact us through primary communication channels such as by telephone or email.

We use social sharing buttons which help share web content directly from web pages to the social media platform in question. Users are advised before using such social sharing buttons that they do so at their own discretion and note that the social media platform may track and save your request to share a web page respectively through your social media platform account.





## **MARKETING** on behalf of clients

We run marketing campaigns on behalf of our clients. This involves processing and storing data using third party technologies such as HubSpot, Survey Monkey etc. In order to do this we comply with GDPR requirements specified by the third party. We process data provided by our clients and any additional data is generated from individuals engaging with our marketing campaigns such as filling in forms via our client's websites, engagement on social media etc. under the relevant lawful bases of consent or legitimate interest.

#### **Email marketing**

You may opt out of receiving this information at any time by unsubscribing from our client's different email communications, this will, however, mean that you won't hear from them about any similar future initiatives, services or offers that may be of interest to your organisation.

#### Websites

If you fill in forms to receive further information via the websites we manage on behalf of our clients, your data will be shared with the relevant client and, if stated at data entry point, included in their marketing communications database going forward. As detailed above, you can unsubscribe from email communication at any point.



## **HOW** long will we keep your personal information

4CM Ltd will only retain information for as long as necessary for the relevant activity. This may be determined by legislation or a decision as to what we consider necessary for the business based on a number of factors.



# WHERE we store your personal data

4CM Ltd has put in place appropriate technical and organisational measures to prevent accidental loss, damage or destruction of your personal data, and to protect your personal data against unauthorised, or unlawful use or theft. We put in place strict confidentiality agreements, including data protection obligations, with our third-party service providers and data processors. In addition, internal filing systems are held online and are password protected. If sharing data by email, spreadsheets are password protected. We also operate a clean desk policy at our offices. Entry to all mobile devices, laptops and computers are password protected.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.





## WHERE your information is shared

Under the legal bases of legitimate interest, consent or contract, we may share information about you with our employees, officers, agents, suppliers or subcontractors insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes as set out in this privacy policy. This includes sharing personal information such as dietary requirements and accessibility needs etc with third parties such as event venues.

In addition, we may disclose your personal information:

- a. to the extent that we are required to do so by law
- **b.** in connection with any legal proceedings or prospective legal proceedings
- **c.** in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk)
- d. to the purchaser (or prospective purchaser) of any business or asset which we are (or are contemplating) selling
- e. we may disclose your personal information to third parties:
  - In the event that we sell or buy any business or assets, in which case we may disclose
    your personal data to the prospective seller or buyer of such business or assets
  - If 4CM Ltd or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case
    personal data held by it about its clients will be one of the transferred assets.





## **WHAT** are your rights

You have a number of rights when it comes to having a say in how we use, store, process and manage your personal data:

You have the right to be informed about how we will use data some information is provided in this privacy document but there will also be notices at point of data collection.

You have the right to object to your data being used or to request that we correct any information that we hold that is false or inaccurate.

You can also ask us to delete data and/or restrict processing of your data. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data. ## **ACCESS** to information
